

## **The International Society of Materials Modelling (ISMM) “Distinguished Career Achievement Award in Materials Modelling”**

**Description:** This award recognizes and honours an individual who has advanced the field of materials modelling through innovative, career-long research contributions.

**Eligibility:** An individual who has made significant and lasting impact in materials modelling and who had a distinguished career of twenty years or more.

**Prize:** An engraved plaque, a \$1500 award, economy class travel to, accommodation at, and complimentary registration for the International Multiscale Materials Modelling (MMM) Conference in which the award is presented. The winner must accept the award in person at the MMM Conference Banquet.

### **Procedures:**

- **Nominator Eligibility**

- The nominator should be a researcher who has either:
  - Attended at least two of the previous five MMM conferences (this condition will be retired at the end of 2026).
  - Is a member of the ISMM for a minimum of 2 continuous years.
- ***Members of the ISMM Board of Directors are ineligible to submit nominations or supporting letters.***

- **Nominee Eligibility**

- The nominee should be either:
  - A researcher who has attended at least two of the previous five MMM conferences (this condition will be retired at the end of 2028).
  - Is a member of ISMM for a minimum of 4 continuous years on the year they are nominated.
- A Researcher who is still active in the field.
- ***Members of the ISMM Board of Directors are ineligible to be nominated.***

- **Additional Details:**

- All nominations will remain active for up to 2 consecutive award cycles. The nominee’s application may be updated, or documents replaced upon request from the nominator.
- Self-nominations are not accepted.

- **Nomination Package**

- A proposed citation of 25 words or less highlighting the major contributions of the nominee.
- A nomination letter from the nominator of no more than 2-pages in length
- The nominee’s curriculum vitae of no more than ten pages.

- Up to three additional supporting letters from individuals familiar with the nominee's research contributions and achievements (each letter should be no more than two pages).
- All documents should be submitted by the nominator as a single PDF file by email with title "ISMM Distinguished Career Award" to [jelawady@jhu.edu](mailto:jelawady@jhu.edu).
- Deadline: August 15<sup>th</sup> 2024.

**Evaluation:**

- Nomination packages are due on August 1, 2024.
- The Executive Committee (EC) of the ISMM will screen all applications for eligibility and completeness and submit all eligible applications to the ISMM board of Directors.
- The ISMM board of Directors will evaluate all applications and vote for the award winner. In case of a multiway tie, the ISMM Presidents selects the winner.
